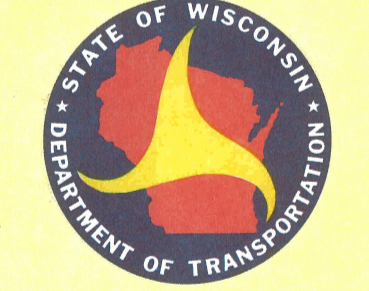

**WISCONSIN HISTORICAL MARKERS**  
More than 100 historical markers along Wisconsin's highways tell a fascinating saga—of the long-vanished Indian tribes whose unique arrow-shaped burial mounds still dot the state, of the voyagers and explorers who followed a trail blazed in 1624 by Jean Nicot, and of the pioneering miners, lumberjacks and farmers who created today out of yesterday's wilderness. The markers pay tribute to outstanding citizens who made substantial contributions in the fields of literature, politics, architecture, education, medicine and conservation, and to notable events such as the world's first auto race, the founding of the first kindergarten, the nation's worst fire disaster, and the birthplace of the circus. Wherever you are in Wisconsin, the highway is your invitation to encounter with history—and the people, places and events that shaped Wisconsin's destiny.
