BUCKLE UP - IT'S THE LAW: Wisconsin law requires all drivers and passengers to wear seat belts.

- Children up to age 1 and 20 pounds must be in a rear-facing child safety seat, always in the back seat. Children up to age 4 and 40 pounds must be in a child safety seat, secured in a rear passenger seat. Children up to age 6, 80 pounds, or 57" tall must be buckled up and in a booster seat.
